

Directory is arranged as follows :---

1-Name of individual or firm.

2—The figures following the letter r indicate the number of the road on which the party resides, and will be found by reference to the map in the back part of this work. Where no road number is given the party is supposed to reside in the village.

3-Birth, if given, sometimes followed by wife's name.

4-Business or occupation.

5-A star (*) placed before a name indicates an advertiser in this work.

6-Figures placed after the occupation of a farmer indicate the number of acres owned or leased.

7-Names in CAPITALS are those who have kindly given their patronage to the work, and without whose aid its publication would have been impossible.

The fact that a farmer is not credited with cows or horses should not imply that he has none. In some towns we have not (but in exceptional cases) recorded horses or cows unless there were more than two.

SENECA County was formed from Cayuga, March 24, 1804. A portion of Tompkins was taken off in 1817, and a part of Wayne in 1823. The railways of the county are the New York Central and the Lehigh Valley. The Erie canal crosses the north-eastern corner. The Seneca canal extends along the Seneca river through the towns of Seneca Falls and Waterloo.

COVERT.

COVERT was formed from Ovid, April 7, 1817, and Lodi was taken off in 1826. Farmer, the principal village, and Covert are stations on the eastern branch of the Lehigh Valley, Ry.

West Fayette and MacDougall are stations on the eastern branch of the Lehigh Valley Ry. and Yale is a station on the western branch.
