CITY OF ITHACA.

CITY WARDS.

FIRST WARD—All that part of said city lying on the west-erly side of the middle of Corn, Park Place and Fifth streets.

SECOND WARD—All that part of said city bounded as fol-lows: Beginning on the south boundary of said city in the center of Corn street; running thence north along the center of said Corn street to its intersection with State street; thence east along center of said State street to its intersection with Tioga street; thence north along the center of said Tioga street to its intersection with Buffalo street; thence east along the center of said Buffalo street, Dryden road and Maple street to the east boundary line of said city; thence south along the east boundary of said city to the south boundary line of said city; thence west along the south boundary of said city to the place of beginning.

THIRD WARD—All that part of the city lying on the east of the center of Corn street, center of Park Place, center of Fifth street, and north of the center of State street, and west of the center of Tioga street.

FOURTH WARD—All that part of said city lying east of the center of Tioga street and north of the center of Buffalo street, Dryden road and Maple street.

The legislative powers of the State are vested in the State Legislature, which consists of two houses, Senate and Assembly.

The State is divided into fifty Senatorial districts, each choosing one Senator.

The Assembly consists of 150 members.

CITY OF ITHACA ELECTION DISTRICTS.

First election district of said city shall comprise all that territory in the city west of Cayuga Inlet and north of the center of Mill street and west of the center of Park Place and Fifth street, thence west of Cayuga Inlet to city line.

Second election district of said city shall comprise all that territory in the city east of the Cayuga Inlet and south of the center of Mill street, and west of the center of Park Place and Corn street.

Third election district of said city shall comprise all that territory in the city east of the center of Corn street and south of the center of State street, and west of the center of Geneva and Spencer streets.

Fourth election district of said city shall comprise all that territory in the city east of the center of Geneva and Spencer streets, and south of the center of State street from Geneva street to Tioga street, and east of the center of Tioga street from State street to Buffalo street, and south of the center of Buffalo street from Tioga street to Aurora street and west of the center of Aurora street to city line.

Fifth election district of said city shall comprise all that territory in the city east of the center of Aurora street and south of the center of Buffalo street, and center of Eddy street to Dryden road, and south of the center of Dryden road and Maple street to city line.

Sixth election district of said city shall comprise all that territory in the city north of the center of State street and west of the center of Tioga street, and south of the center of Mill street, and east of the center of Corn street and Park Place.

Seventh election district of said city shall comprise all that territory in the city, north of the center of Mill street and west of the center of Tioga street and east of the center of Cayuga street and Cascadilla creek and Lake avenue, and north to city line.

Eighth election district of said city shall comprise all that territory in the city, west of the center of Cayuga street and Cascadilla creek, and north of the center of Mill street and east of the center of Park Place and Fifth street and Cayuga Inlet, to city line.

Ninth election district of said city shall comprise all that territory in the city, north of the center of Buffalo street and Eddy street to Dryden road, and north of the center of Dryden road and Maple street, and east of the center of Tioga street, and south of Cascadilla creek from Tioga street east to the intersection of Linn street and University avenue to the east line of the city.

Tenth election district of said city shall comprise all that territory in the city, north of Cascadilla creek from Tioga street east to the intersection of Linn street and University avenue, and east and north of the center of University avenue.

Eleventh election district of said city shall comprise all that territory east of the east line of the Renwick Farm and east and south of the Corporation, up to and including the east side of the Danby road.

Twelfth election district of said city shall comprise all that territory west of Cayuga lake, north, west and south of the Corporation, up to and including the west side of the Danby road.

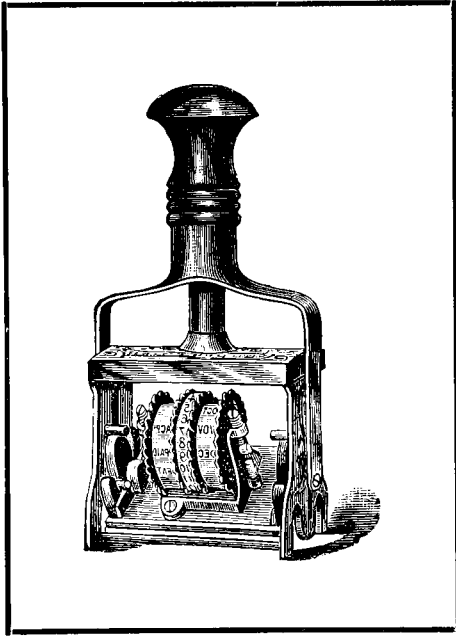
