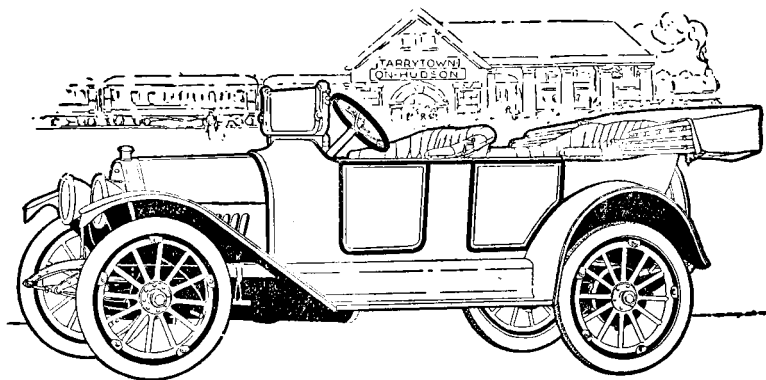

First Ward—All that part of said city bounded on the east by a line commencing in the north line of said city in the center of the Cayuga inlet, or the center line of Cayuga inlet extended, thence running up the center of said inlet to the center of Fifth street, or Fifth street extended, southerly along the center of Fifth street to the center of Cascadilla street; east along the center of Cascadilla street to the center line of Park place; south along the center of Park place to the center line of Buffalo street; west along the center of Buffalo street to the center line of Corn street, and south along the center line of Corn street, extended, to the south line of the city.

Second Ward—That part of said city bounded by the south line of the city, the center line of Aurora street to the center line of Buffalo street, the center line of Buffalo street to the center of Tioga street, the center line of Tioga street to the center of State street, the center line of State street to the center of Corn street, and the center line of Corn street, extended, to the south line of the city.

Third Ward—That part of said city bounded by the center line of State street, the center line of Tioga street to the center of Mill street, the center line of Mill street to the center of Cayuga street, the center line of Cayuga street to the center line of Cascadilla creek, the center line of Cascadilla creek and Lake avenue extended, to the north line of the city by said north line to the center of Cayuga inlet, or center line of Cayuga inlet extended, the center line of Cayuga inlet to the center of Fifth street, or Fifth street extended, the center line of Fifth street to the center of Cascadilla street, the center line of Cascadilla street to the center of Park place, the center line of Park place to the center of Buffalo street, the center line of Buffalo street to the center of Corn street, the center line of Corn street to the center of State street, the center line of State street to the center of Tioga street.

Fourth Ward—That part of said city bounded by the south and east lines of the city, the center line of University avenue to the center of Cascadilla creek and Linn street, the center

line of Cascadilla creek to the center of Tioga street, the center line of Tioga street to the center of Buffalo street, the center line of Buffalo street to the center of Aurora street and the center line of Aurora street to the south line of the city.

Fifth Ward—That part of said city bounded by the east line of the city from the center of University avenue north, the northerly line of the city as far west as the center of Lake avenue extended, the center line of Lake avenue extended and the center line of Cascadilla creek as far southerly as the center of Cayuga street, the center line of Cayuga street to the center of Mill street, the center line of Mill street to the center of Tioga street, the center line of Tioga street to the center of Cascadilla creek, the center line of Cascadilla creek to the center of Linn street and University avenue, and the center line of University avenue to the east line of the city.

CITY OF ITHACA ELECTION DISTRICTS

FIRST WARD, FIRST DISTRICT

Beginning at the intersection of the south corporation line and the Cayuga Inlet running thence in a northerly direction along the center of Cayuga Inlet to Mill street; thence easterly in the center of Mill street to Park place; thence in Park place to Cascadilla street; thence in Cascadilla street to Fifth street; thence in Fifth street extended to the Cayuga Inlet; thence northerly in the Cayuga Inlet to a monument in the Light House Pier at the north corporation line as amended in 1914; thence westerly along said north corporation line to the east side of the Lehigh Valley Railroad right-of-way; thence southerly along said right-of-way to the north corporation line as it existed prior to the amendment of 1914; thence westerly along said north corporation line to the west corporation line; thence southerly along the west corporation line to the south corporation line; thence easterly along the south corporation line to the place of beginning.

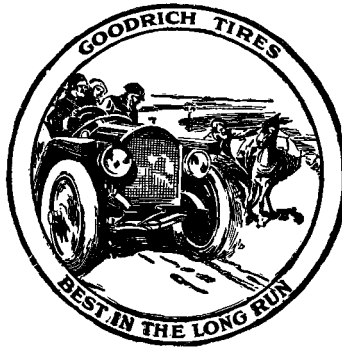
