CIRCULAR FOR 1863--4.

Location.

This Institution is located in the beautiful village of Ithaca, Tompkins County, N. Y. It is accessible by steamboat on Cayuga Lake, connecting with trains on the New York Central Railroad ; by the Delaware, Lackawanna & Western Railroad, intersecting the New York & Erie at Owego ; and by several daily lines of Stages.

Course of Study.

The system of instruction in this Institution contemplates such a thorough and symmetrical training of its students as shall fit them for the duties and enjoyments of life, for the higher Commercial and Professional pursuits, and for an advanced standing in our best Colleges.

The studies have been arranged for courses of three and four years, to commence with the Fall Term of 1863-4 ; and Academic Diplomas will be awarded to those who, on due examination, shall be found to have completed these courses or their equivalent.

Candidates for admission to the course, will be examined in Grammar, Geography, Arithmetic to Ratio and Proportion, and Algebra to Simple Equations.

Students can enter at any period of the course, by being examined on the previous studies or their equiv-

alent ; or, in some cases, by bringing up the deficient studies by extra study.

To accommodate students who do not wish to take the regular academic course, classes will be formed each term, as hitherto, in Arithmetic, Grammar, Geography, Algebra, Geometry, and in such other studies as the wants of the students may demand. This course, therefore, which is similar to the courses established in many reputable Academies, will not interfere in the slightest particular with the accommodation of those who do not wish to take the full course.

**Library and Apparatus.**

The Academy is furnished with a good Library to which students have access free of charge. The cabinet of minerals is ample for the purpose of illustration.



During the current year the Institution has added to its former excellent apparatus, a set of splendid instruments at an expense of \$450, and has at hand the means for a nearly equal addition during the coming year. A fine Scientific Recitation Room has also been recently fitted up; so that this Institution has, in every respect, unrivalled facilities for teaching the Natural Sciences successfully.

**Literary Society.**

The Philologian Lyceum has long been in successful operation, and affords good facilities for improvement. At its last Anniversary the Address was delivered by C. W. MERRITT, ESQ., and the Poem by H. D. CUNNINGHAM, ESQ., both graduates of the School.

**Examinations, Declamation, &c.**

There are public examinations of the classes at the close of every term. All the students are required to appear in declamation or composition once in two weeks. From these rhetorical exercises, and from the public examinations, no student is ever excused, extraordinaries alone excepted.

**Government.**

The intercourse of the students with their instructors, and with each other, is expected to conform to the proprieties and courtesies of good society. A daily record is kept of the attendance, deportment, and scholarship of each student; summaries of these records are made up every month in a permanent form; and a report is furnished to each student at the close of each month for the parent or guardian to sign and return to the principal. The maximum, or highest attainable mark in each respect, is noted in the report,

and is found by multiplying ten by the number of days over which the report extends.

**Teacher's Department.**

Special instruction in the theory and practice of teaching, will be given during the Fall and Winter Terms to such as desire to teach. It is expected that a class will be formed at the beginning of the Winter Term, under the direction of the Regents of the University, in which class instruction will be given, free of charge, to twenty pupils who are of the requisite age, and who comply with the required conditions.

**BOARD**, including room, washing, &c., may be obtained at prices varying from \$2,00 to \$2,50 per week.

Good rooms may be procured at moderate rates in the dwellings of private families, or in the Academy building, for those who wish to board themselves.
